Show Creator

I'm Joe Patrina, singer/songwriter and producer of the *Welcome To The Barn* reality show DVD.

A few years ago in Connecticut, I constructed "The Barn", a full-blown sound stage with heating, air conditioning, top stage lighting, sound reinforcement, and professional grade musical equipment.

After staging 100 live shows something magical happened.

Because of the Barn's intimacy, the audience, in effect, joined the band, but more, *THE BAND JOINED THE AUDIENCE*!

Suddenly everyone was in the band, and the fans started raving about the atmosphere, saying that I had to take the whole experience to a national level. I decided to create a reality show where America's living rooms could be brought inside the barn's inner circle!

In addition to filming the enclosed pilot feature, we released *a* "live "CD to Jango Radio, receiving 5,000 likes from a much younger demographic then the one experienced at the barn itself.

We want to reach this expansive baby boomer/young adult demographic through a scripted reality/sitcom format.

Episode Content



In our "musician's" world, there are many stories, personalities and songs that can fuel episodes, with each episode a blend of drama, comedy and performance excerpts. Episodes are structured both to stand on their own and to build a show legacy that is drawn upon each week. Episode examples:
